Missing

Near the end of his first tour of operations, Flt.-Lieut. Alex Campbell, 20, formerly of King, failed to return from a raid of July 29 and has been officially posted as missing. His mother, Mrs. Ella Campbell, Queensway, Humber Bay, has been notified. He commenced operations as a pilot last May. Enlisting in the R.C.A.F. in March, 1942, he received his wings and commission at Brantford in April, 1943, and had been overseas since July, 1943. Flt.-Lieut. Campbell was born at King, where he attended public school and was a graduate of Aurora High school.
